# LANDSCAPE OF LIGHT THE RETIRO PARK

The Paseo del Prado and Jardines del Buen Retiro, landscape of the Arts and Science, is a cultural landscape resulting from successive transformations created with the express intention of uniting culture and nature in an urban environment. The Retiro Park is a former royal park, historically and geographically linked to the Paseo del Prado. Both, promenade, and park, form an indissoluble whole whose origin dates to the mid-sixteenth century when for the first time a space was conceived for all citizens, regardless of class, to enjoy nature within the walls of the city, with tree plantations and fountains along with other ornamental and recreational elements.
