

LANDSCAPE OF LIGHT-THE PASEO DEL PRADO

The Paseo del Prado and Buen Retiro, landscape of the Arts and Science, is a cultural landscape resulting from successive transformations created with the express intention of uniting culture and nature in an urban environment. The Paseo del Prado is a tree-lined promenade where the major cultural, scientific, political, economic, and representative institutions of the Kingdom of Spain and Madrid society are located. Next to the Prado are the Jardines del Buen Retiro, a former royal park, historically and geographically linked to this promenade. Both, promenade, and park, form an indissoluble whole whose origin dates to the mid-sixteenth century when for the first time a space was conceived for all citizens, regardless of class, to enjoy nature within the walls of the city, with tree plantations and fountains along with other ornamental and recreational elements.
